

2022 GREEN GATHERING TRAFFIC CREW

We're excited to welcome both new and old faces for this year's Festival. It's been a while now since we've met together on our beautiful festival site and everyone is more than ready to celebrate and make it the best yet!

We have our own lovely crew camping area and aim to co-create a fun, welcoming and supportive experience as well as a safe and professional working environment. Here are some details so you have an idea what you're applying for. We have a great core team of supervisors and experienced crew to help you learn the ropes.

The Traffic Crew's main aim as the first onsite festival contact, is to provide a relaxed, safe and welcoming experience for both public and crew. New arrivals at the festival have often had a long, tiring and sometimes stressful journey so a warm welcome from the Traffic Crew can make all the difference.

You can choose to work: 1) 4x5 hour shifts, with one meal only for each shift worked (similar to the stewards' arrangement), or 2) 5x5 hour shifts with all meals included on working days. You will need to let us know in advance which option you prefer. We have overlapping shifts, so we expect the actual working time to be less than 5 hours. Our working day will be from 9.30 am to 11pm (three shifts during this time) so no early starts or late finishes and we plan to give each volunteer a free day over the weekend. Most of you will be part of a team making sure traffic (both vehicle and pedestrian) is safely and smoothly processed onto and off site and we also need a few people who are great at more of an admin role (keeping our daily log, manning the phone, supporting shift changeover etc.)

We expect you to arrive on Tuesday 2nd August in time to set up camp and attend a training session on Tuesday afternoon and to leave on Tuesday 9th August (or Monday 8th after your last shift if you're not working on Tuesday). Most volunteers will work from Wednesday 3rd July. We have a limited number of shifts during set-up (experienced crew only) and pack-down and might also be able to work something out if you need to arrive later or leave earlier if we know well in advance.

New volunteers are required to pay a fully refundable deposit of 80 pounds which will be paid back into your bank account at the end of the festival when you have completed your agreed shifts. Payment details will be sent to you once your application has been accepted.
